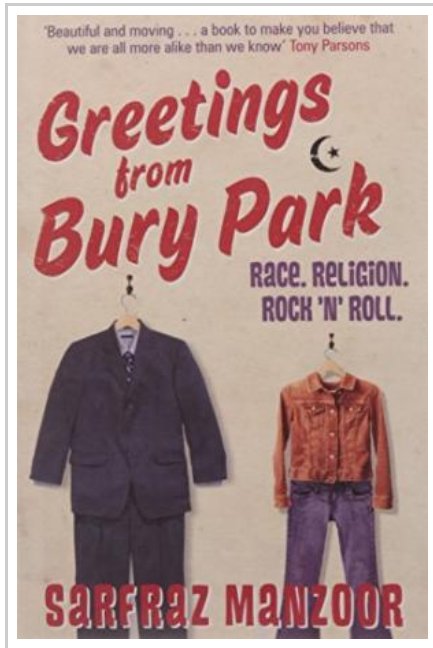



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Greetings from Bury Park: Race. Religion. Rock 'n' Roll
