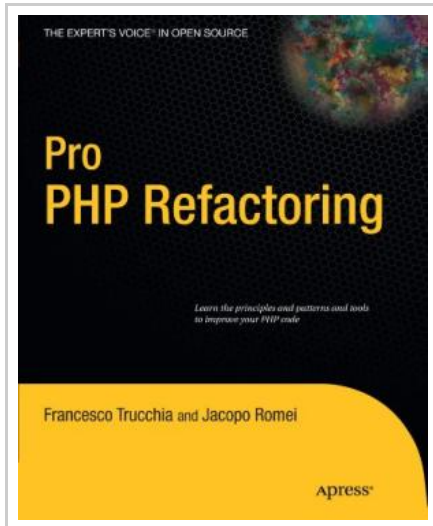




Pro PHP Refactoring
