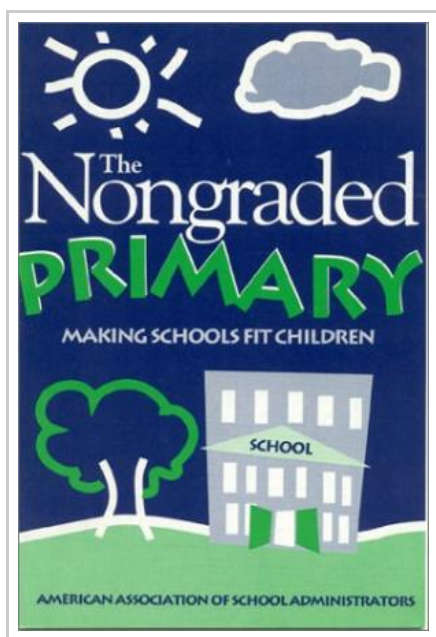




Nongraded Primary: Making Schools Fit Children
