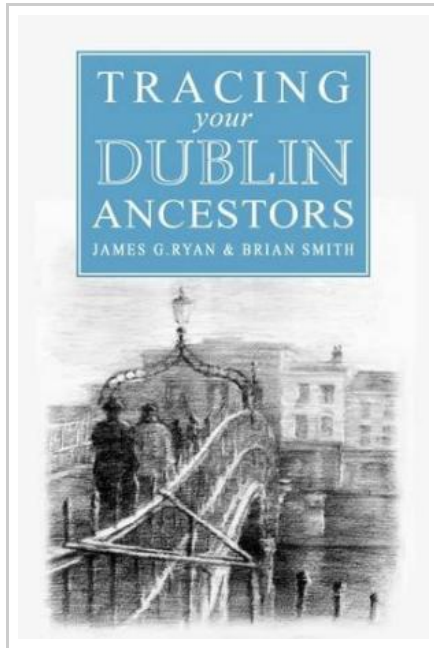




A Guide to Tracing Your Dublin Ancestors
